Via Bonanno Pisano, the Department includes the Degree Programs in the field of Health Sciences.

The courses provide an advanced scientific training in health disciplines, in addition to fundamental multidisciplinary knowledge.

They make use of theoretical and practical lessons through laboratory exercises .



## Our degree programmes

## · First cycle (Bachelor) degree

#### SCIENCE OF HERBAL PRODUCTS AND HEALTH (SPES)

The course is divided in **3 years** (180 ECTS) and offers three different curricula:

- Herbal sciences
- · Information for health
- · Quality control
- Employment opportunities include implementation, control and monitoring of the various stages of production of drugs, medical devices and products for the health.

## Long cycle (Master) degree

#### PHARMACEUTICAL CHEMISTRY AND TECHNOLOGY (CTF)

- · The course is divided in 5 years (300 ECTS)
- · Theoretical and applicative levels
- · Production, formulation and quality control of drugs and health-related products

Graduates will acquire the skills for her/him to be hired as professional pharmacist and chemist.

## Second cycle (Master)

### SCIENCE OF THE HUMAN NUTRITION (SNU)

The course lasts **2 years** (120 ECTS) and offers two different curricula:

- · Biomedical
- · Chemical

The course aims to form an independent professional who has specific knowledge and skills in the field of food and nutrients and is therefore able to estimate the composition, the nutritional quality, safety and suitability of the food for human consumption.

#### PHARMACY (FAR)

- · The course is divided in 5 years (300 ECTS)
- · Activity and therapeutic use of drugs and toxic substances action
- · Biological and microbiological control of medicinal products

Graduates will be experts on drugs able to cooperate with general practitioners, patients and medical structures.



## ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSES FOR ERASMUS STUDENTS

The courses are offered by the Interdepartmental Language Centre (<u>CLI</u>) – Via Santa Maria, 36.

Students are required to take an Entry Test (even absolute beginners) to establish their knowledge level when they start.

To get your certificate of attendance you must have attended for at least 80 % of the total hours; to get the knowledge certificate you must pass the test at the end of the course. To get ECTS credits (4) it is necessary to satisfy these conditions and, where required, have completed the self-study activities in language laboratory by the end of the course.

## **MEALS**


The University of Pisa offers a low-price dining service to its students.
